

Thinking of returning to nursing?



If you have not practised in the last 5-10 years, the Nurse Re-entry Program can support your journey back into the nursing workforce through general practice. You will receive help to regain your registration and return to nursing through a paid, supervised placement in a general practice. All you need to do is apply and we'll match you with a suitable practice.

Who can apply?

For enrolled nurses (EN) and registered nurses (RN), you must have:

- completed training as an EN or RN, are not currently registered and have not practised in the last 5-10 years.

For nurse practitioners (NP), you must:

- have completed training as a NP, are not currently registered and have not practised in the last 5-10 years.
- OR**
- be currently practising in another specialty and interest in transitioning to general practice.

How it works

1. Complete an expression of interest form.
2. We will contact you to confirm eligibility.
3. We will work to find and connect you with a local practice.
4. We will provide information and support to guide you through the process.

Take the first step back into nursing – submit your expression of interest.
